The Power Rock Band

Fall and Bounce was born in 2007 in the name of Rock and ever since they've been sending audiences wild on stage and increasing their fan base.

Fall and Bounce started out as a duo who wanted to do more than just perform Power Rock; Line Breal (vocals and bass) and Guillaume Bruy (guitar and backing vocals) wanted to live it.

Line started at music school at the age of 6. The multi-talented artist soon began to focus on her passion for singing and the violin, which she graduated in a few years later. The teenager constantly listened to the big American rock and hard rock groups whose song writing skills and stage presence she looked up to. She later found these qualities in Guillaume with whom she created Fall and Bounce inspired by Mike Dirnt (Green Day), Dusty Hill (ZZ Top), Blasko (Rob Zombie, Ozzy Osbourne), James Hetfield (Metallica) and many more.

The young self-taught guitar player Guillaume was so passionate about his guitar that he soon joined a professional group and moved to Paris. He has always written songs and played in several groups before finding a kindred spirit in Line. A born musician, he was surprised to find he could play blues and country music as well as he plays death metal but his passion has always been for good old hard-hitting rock music. His heroes are great guitarists and songwriters: Joe Perry (Aerosmith), Jerry Cantrell (Alice in Chains), Randy Rhoads (Ozzy Osbourne), John5 (Rob Zombie and his excellent solo albums).

The duo is as together on the stage as they are in their personal life. Fall and Bounce doesn't have a regular drummer but prefers to get freelance musicians to suit its concerts and recordings. Whilst other bands make ridiculous changes to the line-up, Fall and Bounce has a sound foundation that guest drummers and guitarists build on, like the unforgettable February 2011 concert at l'Elysée Montmartre when they were support act for the ANGRA tour.

The group's first album, "Taste of your Medicine" produced by MVS-Anticraft, also came out in February 2011. The opus has propelled the group to the stages of Paris (Batofar, Le Réservoir etc.) and the rest of France such as the RockaMartiel Festival with English band, Kill the Young.

Hugo Schafer-Burguière is the current drummer in the unholy trinity.

The result is everything newcomers to the band could hope for: an abundance of positive energy, scathing and deafening riffs, heavy beats from the bass and Line's voice wreaking havoc. The beautiful bassist doesn't just have a body for sin; her voice could make the angels cry. Make like a bat out of hell and grab the group's latest album, 'Smashed to Pieces'.
